




Professor Chris Clayton  
Chris Clayton is Professor of Infrastructure Engineering and Head of the School of Civil Engineering and the Environment at the University of Southampton. He is currently the Editor of *Géotechnique*, was the founding Editor of *Geotechnical Engineering*, part of the Proceedings of the Institution of Civil Engineers, and has been the Scientific Editor of the Quarterly *Journal of Engineering Geology and Hydrogeology*. He is the author of about 200 papers and books, including textbooks on 'Site Investigation' and on 'Earth pressures and earth-retaining structures', and has contributed to 5 CIRIA reports, on the procurement of ground investigations, the Standard Penetration Test, the Chalk, and CFA Piling in Chalk.
